These criteria are supported by the following indicators of competence: knowledge of the educational program and methodology for the development of various types of children's activities; ability to design, plan and implement an integrated pedagogical process; research technologies, pedagogical monitoring, teaching and learning of children.

In addition, the educator, who has the right to choose basic and partial programs and preferences, must skillfully combine them, enrich and expand the content of each direction, avoid "mosaics", form the integrity of the child's perception. In other words, a competent
