This article focuses on the reforms aimed at developing youth entrepreneurship in Uzbekistan, the importance of the decisions and decrees adopted by the President in building the future of youth. There are also state youth programs, their implementation, the benefits created.

We all know that the most important and responsible task today is to bring up our young generation, who are the future of our country, as full-fledged, educated, talented people. Therefore, this task was approached in a unique, modern way during the quarantine days, that is, classes were continued online, a special "online school" project was organized through the media, which is important for the meaningful organization of education and leisure of our youth. The organizational and legal framework for the protection of all rights and freedoms, opportunities and interests of schools, which were re-established after quarantine, is improving with the times. It should be noted that our country is a country of happy young people; about 64% of the population are young people under 30 years of age. Of course, given the great responsibility of our state, it requires a lot of attention and care, and on the other hand, the attention paid to our youth will bring great success and results tomorrow. Because now more than half of Uzbekistan's labor force is young.

In the future, every third leader will be young. In this regard, it is no exaggeration to say that the adoption of the Law of the Republic of Uzbekistan "On State Youth Policy" was a novelty in the creation of legal mechanisms for the full support of youth. The law also includes additional measures for state support of youth, state support for gifted and talented youth, youth entrepreneurship, and norms for youth social services. In particular, the International Olympiad of Young Mathematicians named after the great scientist Muhammad al-Khwarizmi was successfully held in Uzbekistan., to support gifted and talented youth. In practice, the main purpose of the introduction of state awards such as creativity, presidential schools, specialized schools, gold and silver medals, and winners of science Olympiads, Zulfiya, "Brave Boy" and "Builder of the Future" is to ensure the viability and implementation of the law. The above-mentioned ideas testify to the high attention paid to the younger generation in our country. In addition, as a result of the implementation of the state program "Year of Youth Support and Public Health", "Youth Book" and "Youth Programs" in recent years, 596 thousand young people were employed and 25.7 thousand young people with disabilities and those in need of medical care were constantly monitored. "The Youth Book" fund generated 382.8 billion soums from the collection of 15% of the local budget and executive documents. young people. In order to develop youth entrepreneurship, finance innovative, startup and business projects based on new ideas, 3.2 trillion soums were allocated for soft loans to 132,000 young people. After all, the education and care that Uzbekistan provides to young people today is a practical expression of attention.

The Presidential Decree about "On measures to radically improve the system of work with youth in the neighborhoods" was adopted on January 19 in 2022. In order to introduce new management mechanisms for working with young people, to create a vertical system of working with them, the position of youth leader will be introduced in every town, village, as well as in every neighborhood in cities, towns and villages. The main tasks of the youth leader are:

- Entering the necessary information about young people into the electronic platforms "Youth Book" and "Youth Portal", to organize effective work with them;
- meaningful organization of youth leisure;
- Increasing the social activity of young people, to encourage their talents and initiatives and to help them find their place in life;
- Educating young people in the spirit of patriotism and ensuring their intellectual development and spiritual development;
- Systematic work with young people prone to delinquency.

Leaders will hold competitions in makom, baxshi and variety, the Rainbow Stars children's art festival, as well as mini-football, volleyball, basketball, table tennis, cycling, running, chess, checkers, badminton, and archery in their neighborhoods. A 5,000-foot health marathon and the Young Ecologist campaign also will be organized by youth leaders. Each quarter, the top 100 leaders in the country who achieve high results in the effective implementation of youth policy in the neighborhood are awarded a one-time cash prize equal to one month's salary. In addition, according to this resolution, the following is established:

- ✓ Dealing with youth issues and coordination of these activities in the regions is carried out personally by the Chairman of the Council of Ministers of the Republic of Karakalpakstan, governor of regions, Tashkent city and districts (cities);
- ✓ The staffing of leaders and staff of youth affairs departments of the Agency for Youth Affairs in neighborhoods and educational institutions will be formed by reducing the staffing of 10,008 youth leaders in general secondary schools;
- ✓ Candidates for leading positions are recruited on the basis of open competitions through the formation of selection commissions headed by governor of districts (cities);
- ✓ Candidates with experience in working with young people, who can follow young people, who set an example by their personal qualities, who are selfless, loyal and patriotic.

The Agency for Youth Affairs has the right to reward leaders up to 50% of their monthly salary based on performance indicators. In addition, a leader operating in another area will be reimbursed up to twice the BHM rent.
