A strong family is the foundation of a strong society. Therefore, society pays special attention to strengthening families, shaping and improving the universal worldview of

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the individual in family relations.

When deciding on a healthy environment in the family in every possible way, we can approach the following social pedagogical-psychological, spiritual-cultural criteria as advisable:

- > achieving the formation of a positive attitude of youth to sports, including family sports;
- ➤ the rational organization of vital activity in children and the achievement of the formation of reproductive culture;
- A key factor in a healthy lifestyle in a family is the study and widespread promotion of the specific traditions and values of our people;
- ➤ To increase the responsibility, capacity, literacy, pedagogical and psychological competence of parents on the education of children, to ensure the unity of family and social education;
- ➤ To educate a spiritually and physically mature generation in the family, to prepare young people for the construction of family life, to arm themselves with modern professional secrets:
- Achieve the formation of a universal worldview of children in family relationships.

On the territory of Uzbekistan, from time immemorial, the socio-educational power of the family was recognized and highly valued. In the years of independence of Uzbekistan, the value of this assessment increased even more. In particular, in the brochure" the idea of national independence: basic concepts and principles", a special emphasis is placed on the social position of the family in society, its contribution to the development of society, its role in the formation of ideologically basic ideologies in the upbringing of a person: "family is one of the most important social factors of ideological upbringing. Because the family is the basis of society and has many centuries of strong spiritual foundations. The first concepts inherent in our national ideology are absorbed, first of all, in the family environment. This process is carried out through the exhortation of the grandfathers, the lesson of the father, the love of the mother.

The family is a place for a person to restore his working capacity and relax. The family is also an important foster home. In the upbringing of children in the family, there is a good udum, habits left over from fathers, mothers, who have passed the tests of life for thousands of years.

Educator olima M.Inomova singled out the following aspects of the family: - the family has its own and inimitable influence; - the family is a kind of "mirror" for the child, and the personal example of the parent, the example of which is important in the upbringing of the child;

- ➤ the family consists of a universe of specific emotions, in which positive and sometimes negative emotions are cumulative;
- in a family setting, children are also brought up with feelings of empathy for others;
- ➤ the participation of a child in domestic life in the family is also considered an important factor in moral education;

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➤ family-reflects the duties of marriage, parenting. The parent's love for each other can become one of the main educational factors that affect the child. So, the family is an educational community, and no one in any case can fulfill the function of the family

According to the family species classification, the Modern Family consists of "monogamous families". However, the modern monogamous family is also in turn divided into a number of other types according to their structure, abandoned ibi, essence and other characteristics. Knowing what types of families of the present time have and their socio-psychological characteristics, studying the problems inherent in them, allows you to prevent possible grievances in family life. Let's talk briefly about these below. The family differs according to the different norms that characterize it:

- 1. According to completeness: complete, irregular and reconfigured (second marriage) families.
- 2. By number of branches: nuclear (consisting of parents and children) and multi-branched (family members of two or more generations living together) families.
- 3. According to the number of children: families without children, with children there, with two children, with three to four children, with five or more children. In different countries, these mezzanines are conspecific. For example, in the United States, France, Germany, Greece, Russia and other developed countries, families with three to four children are multi-child families. In Uzbekistan, such families are included in the Saras of families with an average number of children.
- 4. According to the social background of the couple: workers, peasants, servants, a family of intellectuals, a family of a mixed type.
- 5. According to the couple's level of Education; Higher Education. middle-a family consisting of boats with a special, secondary, unfinished secondary, special auxiliary school education.
- 6. According to the "age" of the family: young family (families with up to 1 year, 3-5 years, 6-10 years of living experience), middle-aged family, mature-aged family (elderly family)
- 7. In terms of the degree of material security of the parent family (parents)of the engaged youth, there are many different and incompatible families in terms of whether the slaves are compatible with each other or whether there is a kata discrepancy between them.
- 8. According to Regional aspects: urban, rural, mixed-type family.
- 9. According to the marriage satisfaction level, at the divorce level a family with a lower level of marital satisfaction, at the middle level, and a family with a higher level of marital satisfaction.
- 10. According to the female or male leadership of the family: the family in which the husband is the leader, the family in which the wife is the leader, the family in which the husband and hoti perform the leadership together (biarchate).
- 11. according to the relationship between the couple in the family: authoritarian, democratic, liberal, mixed-type families.
- 12. According to the nationality of the spouses: monethnic or baynaminal families. International families can in turn be divided into two.

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- Marriages among nationalities whose religion, customs or language is part of the same group, such as Uzbek-Tajik, Uzbek-Kazakh, Uzbek-Turkmen, Russian-Ukrainian, etc.
- Marriages between millatvakils whose religion, customs or language are not part of the same group, such as Uzbek-Russian, Uzbek-Ukrainian, Uzbek-Estonian, Uzbek-German, etc.

A family is a legal union of two young adults who have come of age, on the basis of love, ardor, respect for each other, voluntarily, with the mouth of the heart. In youth, qualities such as sensitivity, responsibility, responsibility begin to take the place of playfulness, innocence, masculinity, apathy. To this every age should be prepared and read, Understanding the goals and objectives of the family, feeling the skill of responsibility.
